This ministry project has already been underway for several months. You can help in several ways.

Below is a list of acceptable items for the shoeboxes.

You can either pack your own shoebox or purchase items for others to pack. We will accept any kid-friendly items you might be able to provide, but as of now, our greatest need is money to put toward shipping costs which have risen to \$9 per box.

School Supplies: pens, pencils & sharpeners, crayons or markers, stamps & ink pad sets, writing pads/paper, solar calculators, coloring & picture books, etc.

Toys: small cars, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, kazoos, harmonicas, yo-yo's, jump ropes, small Etch A Sketch, toys that light up or make noise (with extra batteries), Slinky, etc.

Other: T-shirts, socks, little girls underwear, ball caps, sunglasses, hair clips, toy jewelry, watches, flashlights (with extra batteries)

A Personal Note: You may enclose a note to the child and a photo of yourself or your family. (If you include your name & address, the child may write back.)

Do Not Include: used or damaged items, war-related items such as toy guns, knives or military figures, chocolate or food, candy, liquids/lotions, breakable items such as snow globes or glass items, aerosol cans, medications/vitamins
