

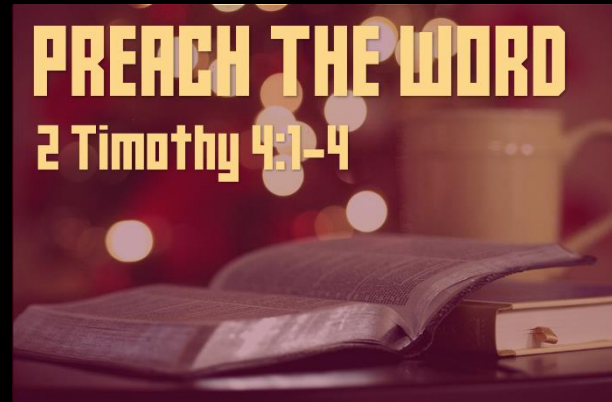

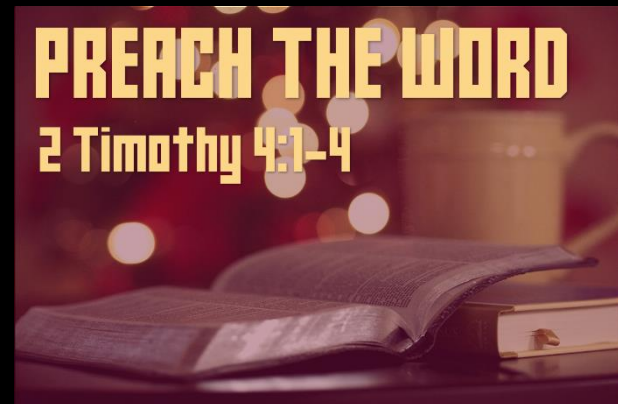

2Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all long suffering and doctrine.



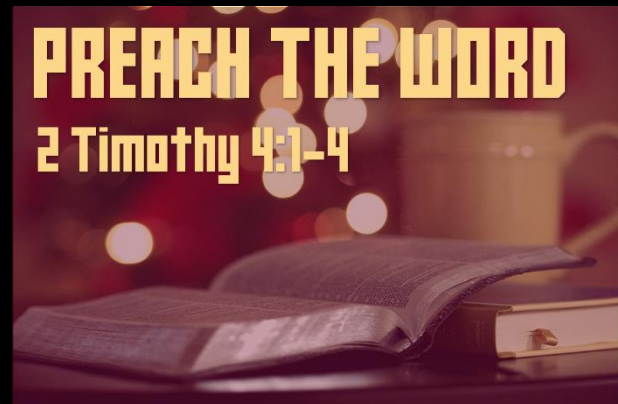
